The Mace and Medallion



The presidential medallion is the symbol of the leadership of the University. The components of the chain represent important dates, academic disciplines, mottos, and other elements that tell the Goodwin University story.

The ceremonial Goodwin University mace is a part of all formal ceremonies and convocations. The mace bearer leads the procession followed by the President and Chair of the Board of Trustees.

The design of the mace is very specific to the University and conveys the traditions of our institution.

The top of the mace is the Goodwin University seal. The four small

symbols attached to the staff are the State of Connecticut seal, the Town of East Hartford seal, 1999, and a ship's wheel representing our mascot, the Navigator.

The Ringing of the Bell

During our Commencement exercises, as the trustees, faculty, and graduates prepare to enter, the valedictorian will signal the start of the processional by ringing the bell.

The reverberations radiating out symbolize our graduates' spirit of possibility and the positive impact they will have, locally and throughout the world, in their chosen careers.

Each ring of the bell signifies a year since the founding of Goodwin University.

Elizabeth M. Giannetta-Ramos

M.S. Organizational Leadership, Goodwin University

Born and raised in Hartford, Liz gives back to the community through her non-profit work with youth. She graduated from Northwest Catholic High School in 1998 and went on to receive her bachelor's degree in Human Services from Springfield College in 2004. Liz spent the first 15 years of her career in the field of youth development and grassroots community organizing, "inheriting" many young people as her own. She co-founded the Southend Knightriders Youth Center in 1995 to create a safe space for young people during a violent era in her city. Liz continues to be a voice for city youth, working in partnership with Hartford Public Schools to bring opportunities to build capacity in them and city residents.

Liz serves as a board member for Youth Challenge and is an active member of Glory Chapel International Cathedral, volunteering for special events and hospitality. She has been recognized for her work in the Frog Hollow neighborhood and was honored with the SINA Neighborhood Service Award in 2020. She also received the Humanitarian Award from Springfield College and was recognized for her 20 years of service to COMPASS.

Liz returned to school in 2019 with a passion and drive to grow in her field of interest and now has received a master's degree in Organizational Leadership from Goodwin University. She currently works as a Director of Partnerships for COMPASS Youth Collaborative, Inc., a non-profit violence prevention organization, and is an independent consultant with Arbonne International. She is still a very active community member, devoted advocate for youth, mom, and wife.



Mary Owens

A.S. Dental Hygiene

As a sibling of a person with intellectual and developmental disabilities, at a young age Mary developed an intense desire to have a professional career that supported people with disabilities. She began her college career in 2010 at the University of Connecticut, where she focused on the specialty of speech-language pathology. While working in the field post-graduation, she began noticing that many of her clients' teeth — from preschool age into late adulthood — were dark and fractured, had lots of tartar, or were missing altogether. During one speech therapy session, part of her adult client's tooth fell onto the floor. The client calmly said, "Oh, don't worry, Mary. This happened yesterday, too." Finding it unacceptable for her clients to have such devastating oral health issues, Mary pivoted toward a new career path.

From 2018 to 2021, she proudly attended Goodwin University with the goal of becoming a registered dental hygienist; she was devoted to learning the art and science of oral health in order to provide exceptional care to all people, especially those with disabilities. Mary continued to work during the majority of her time at Goodwin University. One of her fondest positions was as a work-study research assistant, working closely with Dr. Diana LaRocco, Dean of the School of Applied Liberal Arts and Social Sciences. She learned an immense amount about research and college curriculum development and continues to have a passion for academia. In the past month, Mary has interviewed at a variety of dental offices and settings, including the collegiate level as an adjunct professor. Oral health and overall health are one in the same, and Mary is eager to educate others about this connection and to work with underserved populations. In her spare time, she rides her Harley, kayaks, enjoys gardening, and shoots hoops with her brother.



William "Smokey" Robinson, Jr.

Legendary singer-songwriter, record producer, record executive, and co-founder of Motown Records

"Smokey" Robinson, Jr. is a legendary singer-songwriter, record producer, record executive, and co-founder of Motown Records. Early in his career, he and his group, the Miracles, impressed producer Berry Gordy with Robinson's vocals and ambitious songwriting. With Gordy's help, they released "Got a Job," launching a successful collaboration and the beginnings of Motown. Between 1960 and 1970, Robinson would produce 26 Top 40 hits with the Miracles including such classics as "You've Really Got a Hold on Me," "I Second That Emotion," and "The Tears of a Clown." Robinson was one of the major songwriters and producers for Motown, penning hit singles including "My Guy," "The Way You Do The Things You Do," and "Get Ready." In 1975, he released his most successful solo album, *A Quiet Storm*. His classic hit "Cruisin'" peaked at number four on the Billboard Hot 100. Robinson topped the charts again with "Being With You" and teamed up with fellow Motown artist Rick James on "Ebony Eyes." His million-selling album, *One Heartbeat*, garnered his first Grammy for "Just to See Her." He has been inducted into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame and the Kennedy Center, honored with individual and group stars on the Hollywood Walk of Fame, and awarded the National Medal of Arts, a Heritage Award at the Soul Train Music Awards, and a BET Lifetime Achievement Award.



Andrew Jackson Young, Jr.

Civil and human rights activist

Andrew J. Young, Jr. earned worldwide recognition as a champion of civil and human rights. His dedication to service is illustrated by his extensive leadership experience, including serving as a member of Congress, U.S. Ambassador to the United Nations, mayor of Atlanta, and ordained minister. In the 1960s, he was a key strategist in Civil Rights campaigns that led to the passage of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the Voting Rights Act of 1965. As Ambassador to the UN, he negotiated an end to white-minority rule in Namibia and Zimbabwe and brought President Carter's emphasis on human rights to international diplomacy efforts. As mayor of Atlanta, he brought in over 1,100 businesses, more than \$70 billion in foreign direct investments, and generated over a million jobs. In addition to numerous honorary degrees and honors, he has received an Emmy Lifetime Achievement award and the Dan Sweat Award. His portrait is included in the Smithsonian National Portrait Gallery. Ambassador Young serves on a number of boards including the Martin Luther King Center for Nonviolent Social Change, Morehouse College, Andrew Young School of Policy Studies at Georgia State, and AmericasMart. In 2003, he and his wife, Carolyn McClain Young, founded the Andrew J. Young Foundation to promote education, health, leadership and human rights in the U.S., Africa, and the Caribbean. He currently serves as the Chairman of the Andrew J. Young Foundation. In 2012, he retired from GoodWorks International, LLC, after more than a decade of facilitating sustainable economic development in the business sectors of the Caribbean and Africa.



Kayla Patrick

Kayla is honored to be the valedictorian of Goodwin University's Class of 2021. She was born and raised in Milford, Connecticut, and graduated from Jonathan Law High School in 2015. She earned her first bachelor's degree from Southern Connecticut State University in 2019.
